Required Vaccinations**

- **MMR**
 - 2 doses of Measles vaccine, 2 doses of Mumps vaccine, and 1 dose of Rubella vaccine, OR 2 MMR vaccinations, OR a laboratory report of immunity. Vaccines must be received on or after 12 months of age and each dose must be separated by a minimum of 28 days. Students who were born before 1957 are exempt from the MMR requirement.
- **Varicella**
 - 2 doses of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine, OR a laboratory report of immunity, OR a past history of chickenpox or herpes zoster (shingles) verified by your healthcare provider (MD, DO, NP, PA). Vaccines must be received on or after 12 months of age and each dose must be separated by a minimum of 28 days.
- **Tdap**
 - 1 dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine received within the last 10 years.
- **Hepatitis B**
 - Completion of the Hepatitis B vaccination series required for full-time students only (full time = 3 or more course units/semester)
- **Meningitis ACWY**
 - 1 dose of Meningococcal meningitis ACWY vaccine received on or after 16 years of age is required for the following students:
 - are 18 years of age or younger, living on or off campus.
 - are 19 years of age or older, living on campus, OR living off campus with the following medical risk factors: anatomical or functional asplenia, sickle cell disease, HIV infection, persistent complement deficiency, or complement inhibitor use (e.g., Solaris®, Ultomiris®).
- **Meningitis B**
 - Meningococcal meningitis B vaccine is required for students with the following medical risk factors: anatomical or functional asplenia, sickle cell disease, HIV infection, persistent complement deficiency, or complement inhibitor use (e.g., Solaris®, Ultomiris®).
