The College of New Jersey Student Health Services Graduate Students Required Vaccinations

REQUIRED

*For all students under 31 years of age on the due date of your immunization record

- MMR
- 2 doses of Measles vaccine, 2 doses of Mumps vaccine, and 1 dose of Rubella vaccine, OR 2
 MMR vaccinations, OR a laboratory report of immunity. Vaccines must be received on or after 12
 months of age and each dose must be separated by a minimum of 28 days. Students who were born before 1957 are exempt from the MMR requirement.

REQUIRED

*For all students under 31 years of age taking full time course load = 3 course units/semester.

- Hepatitis B
 - Completion of the Hepatitis B vaccination series required <u>for full-time</u> students only (full time = 3 or more course units/semester)

RECOMMENDED

- Meningitis ACWY
 - 1 dose of Meningococcal meningitis ACWY vaccine received on or after 16 years of age is required for the following students:
 - are 18 years of age or younger, living on or off campus.
 - are 19 years of age or older, living on campus, OR living off campus with the following medical risk factors: anatomical or functional asplenia, sickle cell disease, HIV infection, persistent complement deficiency, or complement inhibitor use (e.g., Solaris®, Ultomiris®).
- Meningitis B
 - Meningococcal meningitis B vaccine is required for students with the following medical risk factors: anatomical or functional asplenia, sickle cell disease, HIV infection, persistent complement deficiency, or complement inhibitor use (e.g., Solaris®, Ultomiris®).
